




Yard Waste

These items can be taken to the Leaf / Tree Site



Grass Clippings Leaves & twigs Houseplants & Garden garden Branches & trees

No Plastic, Glass or Metal

Remove all items from bags

Yard Site Regulations

* Yard waste may be hauled to the collection site behind Riverview Ball Complex. The site is open **April through November** free of charge for residents of Le Mars **ONLY!**
* All yard waste must be un-bagged on site.

Aerosol spray cans (must be empty)

Empty & Clean Recyclables

* Put all other recyclables loose in the recycling tote, not in bags or cartons.
* Up to **\$750** fine for depositing non-recyclables in a recyclable container.

Other Services

Special Pick Up

Residents may have a special pick up for excess garbage/recycling for a fee by calling Van's Sanitation at 548-4644.

Use Only a City Provided Garbage & Recycle Container

For repairs or to order a replacement container, call 712-546-7018.

Additional Garbage

All garbage must fit within the City provided can with the lid closed. You may have an additional garbage tote for a fee.

Excess Recycling

There is a dumpster located on City parking lot north of fire station or you may call City Hall for additional totes.



Other recycling & disposal options

Plymouth County Solid Waste Agency Hours of Operation:

Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm
 2nd Saturdays April – October 8:00 am – noon
 Closed Saturdays November – March

C&D Recycling:

Asphalt Shingles
 Clean Wood (No paint, stain, or treated)
 Plastic (Buckets, barrels, some toys, etc.)

Transfer Station (Door 1, 2 & 3):


All household garbage, carpeting & small furniture will go here.
 All material dropped off at this building **WILL NOT** be recycled.
 Cardboard will be set off to the side along door 1 to be recycled.

There will be an extra fee for:

Appliances
 Fluorescent lights
 Tires (done by size or weight)
 (TV's, computers, printers and other electronics)

Also accepted at the Landfill:

Yard Waste
 Trees
 Metal
 Concrete



FINES

Fines will apply up to \$500 if appliances, tires, fluorescent light fixtures, paints, stains or household hazardous chemicals are found in roll off containers, or any load dumped in C&D area or Transfer Station.



When do I set my Garbage & Recycling Out?

No Permanent Solid Waste Container shall be kept or maintained in a front yard, except for collection - Residential solid waste receptacles or containers shall **not** be placed at the curb more than 12 hours before the scheduled time of collection and shall be removed from the curb promptly following collection.

Containers need to be stored on private property and not City right-of-way.

Hazardous Materials



Prohibited from recycling, yard waste and garbage



Automotive Products such as motor oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, cleaners, degreasers, fuels, oil filters, waxes and windshield washer fluid

 To set up appointments!

Rechargeable batteries such as Ni-Cad, Ni-Mh, Lithium and automotive batteries should not be landfilled.

Oil-based

Products marked "CAUTION," "WARNING," "DANGER," or "POISON" may require hazardous material disposal.

Other key phrases to look for are the following:
 * "Harmful or fatal if swallowed."
 * "Do not use near heat or flame."
 * "Causes severe burns on contact"

Disposal Costs

- *Latex paint \$2.00 per can
- *Farm Chemicals \$2.25 per pound
- *Commercial small quantity Generators \$2.25 per pound

Free Disposal

- *Household cleaners
- *Disinfectants
- *Polishes
- *Batteries
- *Gasoline
- *Antifreeze
- *Stains
- *Paint thinners
- *Lawn chemicals
- *Fertilizers
- *Pesticides
- *Oil base paints
